Bills: Upon review of the bills Dan made a motion to accept the bills as presented. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.

Road report: Bryan received a note in his mailbox about potholes on Gravel Rd. and Cardinal. JoAnn will check the holes on Cardinal and report back to Dan. Nobert has been doing shouldering and is saving the town great amounts of money by doing so. Truck auger is finished and work well. Culverts have been put in where needed.

The rut-wedging that the county did is an extremely poor job. It was discussed to buy a roller so the town could do the work itself.

Workmen's Comp: A report was filled out for next year's insurance policy.

Assessor: Dan made a motion to hire Robert Prokop for assessor for 2021 for a contract cost of \$9200.00. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.

LP Gas: JoAnn presented the board with a contract from the Medford Co-op for L.P at \$1.019 for the 2020-2021 heating season. Dan made a motion to accept the contract. Bryan seconded with the condition that JoAnn wait to sign the contract until Sept. 18 so he could check with FS on their price. Motion carried.

Centennial Community Center: Marian reported that there will be a buffet September 18 with the Strat-Cats. The hall will be having casino night in October. She also discussed applying for some power line grant money for repair of the shelter and a cooler compressor. Will know something by September 30<sup>th</sup>.

Treasures report: The starting balance is \$114,435.30. The income for the month was \$53,743.56 expenses were \$18,591.97. Leaving a balance of \$149,586.89. Bryan made a motion to accept the treasurers report. Dan seconded. Motion carried.
