

## Town of Little Black

### January 10. 2021

Present for the January town meeting was Dan Hoffman, Bryan Jochimsen Chad Smith, JoAnn Smith, and Marian Nernberger. Dan called the meeting to order at 5:15 PM and asked JoAnn to read the December minutes. Chad made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.

Bills: Upon review of the bills Chad made a motion to accept and pay the bills as presented. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.

Road report: Discussed again that some farmer did not irrigate and were using Gilson as a through road for hauling manure. The board will talk with them about the fact they can't wreck the new blacktop with their heavy loads and they will only get one warning from the town, after that it will be the authorities. They then went on to discuss the bridge project on Stetson and culverts on Hemlock & A, Hemlock, Swallow, Stetson, and Castle. Dan reported that the Lights on the truck are now fixed. It was discussed about paying back the \$30,000 that was borrowed from the equipment fund last fall to pay for the blacktop on Gibson. Dan made a motion for Marian to open an equipment fund savings account with the financial institution with the best interest rates for both the \$15,000 from this year and the \$30,000 that has been paid back to the equipment fund. Bryan seconded. Motion carried.

Stimulus money: The stimulus money that was allotted to the township and applied for has been received.

Chuck Zenner: Chuck reported that they now have a company interested in going ahead with the broadband project that the county broadband committee has been working on. Chuck then asked if the board would be interested in having the townhall available for a place where students could use the broadband if it was hooked up by fall. The board agreed to let student use the townhall, but there would need to be supervision.

Centennial Community Center: Marian reported that things have been slow but will be having two carry out buffets in January, the 15<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>. The board's recommendation was to go back to in house buffets and have carry outs

available.

Treasures report: The starting balance was \$100,508.12. and the ending Balance being \$220,138.93.

Chad made a motion accept the treasurers report. Bryan seconded the motion carried.
