Monthly Board meeting
March 8, 2026

Dan called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM with Dan Hoffman, Bryan Jochimsen, Chad Smith, JoAnn Smith, and Tony Schumacher present. Dan opened the meeting by reciting the pledge. He then had JoAnn read the February meeting minutes.

Bryan made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Chad seconded. Motion carried.

Bills: Bill were reviewed and approved with a motion by Chad. Seconded by Bryan. Motion carried.

Gibson Project: Dan then reported that he has been in the process of applying for reimbursement on the Aryes engineering bill for the Gibson project. It appears that there may be more wet land than had been planned.

Medford Pool: As in past the Medford pool would be made available to the Town of Little Black residents at the same cost as City residents for a fee of \$100. Dan made a motion to pay the fee. Chad seconded. Motion carried.

TDS Fiber: TDS called and asked for permission to lay fiber along some township roads. Dan will email them stating they have permission if they stay on the very far edge of the road right- a- way.

LISSIP: Ayres will write the grants for funding on 3 bridge/culverts in the township for a fee of \$500. Bryan made a motion to hire Ayres. Chad seconded. Motion carried.

Chuck Zenner: Chuck reported that the rumor about Big Tussle is false, but they will be building less towers with the push that TDS is putting on with laying fiber.

Co. Electronic Payment: Bryan made a motion to approve electronic payments to the County. Chad seconded. Motion carried.

Treasurer Report: Tony reported a starting balance of \$832,933.04. Income for the month of \$1109.27. Expenses \$540,041.78. Leaving a balance of \$294,000.53. Bryan made a motion to approve the treasures report. Chad seconded. Motion carried.

Bryan made a motion to adjourn at 6:23 PM Chad seconded. Motion carried.
