

Town of Little Black 2020 Annual Meeting April 21, 2020

Chairman Dan Hoffman called the 2020 annual meeting to order at 7 PM. He proceeded by asking the clerk to read the minutes from the 2019 annual meeting. Steve Suchomel made a motion to accept the 2019 annual meetings minutes as written. Chuck Zenner seconded. Motion carried.

Dan then went on to review the 2019 annual report. The starting balance for 2019 was \$156,110.73. Total income for 2019 was \$1,182,440.50. The 2019 total expenses were \$1,187,633.92. Leaving and ending balance of \$150,917.31, plus \$15,225.50 in the equipment fund.

Chuck Zenner made a motion to accept the 2019 annual financial report. Norbert Goessl seconded. Motion carried.

On behalf of the town board chairman Hoffman thanked the boards of the planning committee, and board of appeals committee. He then thanked Norbert Goessl, Troy Hoffman, Bryan Jochimsen, Brent Clarkson, Dan Hoffman road crew, that kept the road clear all winter and for their hard work in maintaining the roads. He also thanked the recycling employees, Andy, Gavin, and Garret.

The next order of business was discussion of roads, and some of the plans for 2020. The roads need a lot of gravel and has holes with this spring break up that need major repairs. The board will be doing their road inspection in the very near future.

Steve Suchomel gave his report to the board stating there were no changes that needed to be done in zoning. He stated that the committee recommends the zoning administrator to give monthly reports on all building permit issued and all details of the permit along with the fee collected. Then at the annual meeting have a complete report from the monthly reports that the attendees can review.

Chuck Zenner only reported that the county board had its reorganizational meeting and that there were not hardly any changes.

A motion was made by Norbert Goessl to hold next year's 2021 annual meeting April 20th at 7 PM. Steve Suchomel seconded. Motion carried.

With no further business Chuck Zenner made a motion to adjourn at 8:10 PM. Marian Nernberger seconded. Motion carried.
