

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Little Black,
Taylor County believes it is in the town's interest to exceed the state levy limit as
described above by a greater percentage than 2%. {Note here insert the option
that applies to your town (a) 2% or (b) percentage of new construction less improvements
removed, if greater than 2%}

Whereas, the Town of Little Black levy was
\$ 109,280.00 for the tax levy in 2005 (collected in 2006); and further
whereas the state limit would limit the increase to \$ 2185.60 for a total allowable
town tax levy of \$ 111,465.60.

Now Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Little Black,
Taylor County does hereby resolve and orders as follows:

1. The town board hereby supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2006 (to be collected in 2007) to exceed the state levy limit.
2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2006 (to be collected in 2007) by 9% percentage, which would increase the town levy by \$ 9835.20 (insert dollar amount of proposed increase) over the past year's levy, for a total town tax levy of \$ 119,115.20 (insert total dollar amount of proposed levy for 2006 tax levy), shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on October 9, 2006.
