### Wisconsin Statute 86.07(2)

Failure to obtain a driveway permit or to comply with the standards in this Ordinance is punishable by a fine of \$50 per violation



The Slope of the driveway shall be constructed as not to drain onto roadway.  
 The Maintenance of the driveway and culvert shall be the responsibility of the applicant.

Issuance of this permit shall not be construed as a waiver of the applicant's obligation to comply with any more restrictive requirements imposed by Taylor County and the Department of Natural Resources. If property is subdivided, or part of a subdivision, this permit is no longer valid.

Building Permits for new construction will not be issued until the culvert installation has been given final approval.

General regulations For Driveways:

1. Include a map indicating the location and dimensions of the desired driveway and highway access locations.
  - A. Include lot lines, access roads and location of parcel.
2. Driveways must intersect with Town Roads and highways at right angles.
3. Driveway should be located a minimum of 150 feet from the center of a town or highway intersection.
4. Driveways shall be placed no closer than 15 feet from the lot line.
5. All driveways and parking areas shall be graded in such a manner so that no storm water, silt, gravel, or other out-wash is discharged onto the roadway.
6. The first 24 feet of the driveway can not exceed a 5% slope at the point where the driveway enters on to a public road.
7. An area equal to driveway width and eighteen (18) feet in height shall be cleared for emergency service vehicles.
